TxDOT to survey Dallas-Fort Worth and see where we need new roads

Survey will begin in February and is completely, totally, 100% voluntary.

In February, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will begin conducting travel surveys to collect information on the amount and characteristics of travel attracted by work places as well as commercial vehicle travel in the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

The information will be used to develop a computerized travel forecasting model that will help TxDOT and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) evaluate and plan future transportation needs, such as:

- Where new roads and transit service should be planned;
- What existing roads and transit routes should be improved; and,
- Which roadway projects being considered over the next few years will be of greatest benefit to the residents of Dallas, Fort Worth, and the surrounding area.

This is your big chance chance to get a DART Rail train pick you up in the morning and take you home at night.

The survey will be conducted by a contractor hired by TxDOT that specializes in transportation and traffic data collection. The contractor will randomly select and contact eligible businesses, agencies, and individuals to request their participation in the survey. If you are an owner or manager of a business or public agency contacted regarding the survey, TxDOT would like to emphasize that participation is voluntary, and greatly encouraged and appreciated.
