

DART's pay-to-park experiment delayed until April

Dallas Area Rapid Transit's two-year experiment in charging some users to park at busy stations won't begin until April, officials said Tuesday.

DART board members voted in August to fix rates for the trial period, and expected to begin charging by this month.
